Comments: In 2004, I have received a number of reports indicating the presence of King Salmon in Gilles Creek. A new road was established in 2004 through Shaw Creek drainage to the Pogo Mine on the Goodpaster River. In 2001, before the road was established, Alaska Boreal Forest Council biologist, Michael Lilly, established a watershed monitoring device at the mouth of Gilles Creek. During a visit to download data on Aug. 9th, 2001 two adult Kings were seen moving upstream into Gilles Creek near the monitoring station. Pictures identify that these were indeed King salmon and they appeared to be in a ripened condition. It was not clear that these fish would actually use Gilles Creek as their spawning location because they were seen near the mouth. In 2004, after the road was established, Jim Farman a Forman with City Electric Company out of Fairbanks came into our office and described four King salmon where the Power line crossed Gilles Creek (~1.5 miles upstream from the mouth of Gilles Creek). He described two adults, a female and male plus two jack kings. He also said that a water truck driver working on the road project saw several King salmon when he was pumping water out of Gilles Creek at the road crossing. These reports and others, likely from the same sources, establish that spawning King salmon exist in Gilles Creek and should be nominated as such. I plan to look for Juvenile KS next summer to further confirm these reports.


