SUBJECT: Fall Run of Chum  
Salmon in Lower  
Fortymile River

As you requested, my technician, Dan Grangaard, inquired around Tok regarding the existence of anadromous fish in the Fortymile River.

George Farren, a longtime resident of Tok, confirmed that Neil "Red" Thurneau, a placer miner, has taken chum salmon from the Fortymile River near Steele Creek. For obvious reasons, it is unlikely that Red or any of his relatives in Tok will personally confirm this. George also told Dan that the chums were taken in September and early October, which would explain why your previous summer investigations failed to document the presence of dog salmon in the river.

My recommendations remain the same. Postpone the declassification of the Fortymile as an anadromous fish river until qualified Department personnel can fly or net the river in fall 1985. Game Division has a suitable 18-foot jet boat in Tok which will be available for this work.

This should have been done years ago.


