Sockeye were part of a stocking program begun in 1998. Fish pass into Solf lake completed in 2000. Sockeye observed in lake. Adult Coho observed in both lake and inlet stream at head of Solf Lake. Juvenile Coho observed in inlet stream at head of Solf Lake. Dolly Varden observed moving up fish pass, in Solf Lake and on spawning redds along lake shoreline. Pink salmon observed in tide water spawning below fish pass.
