In 1977 and 1978 gillnet trapping and adult counts has been conducted. Spring Creek is a major rearing area for coho salmon. Although only a few adults actually spawn in the stream a large number of juvenile coho move out of Wasilla Creek into Spring Creek because of its ideal rearing areas.
