

King Salmon Escapement

I spoke with Dave Rutz today regarding the king salmon escapement on Chiuk Creek. On July 19, 1983, Dave surveyed Chiuk Creek via helicopter and counted approximately 1,200 adult kings. The largest concentrations of spawning salmon were found in the lower third of the creek. However, spawning king salmon were also found as far upstream as the vicinity of Schneider Lake. Dave noted kings in both branches of Chiuk Creek above the forks located just south of Schneider Lake.
