Hi Ed--

I'm looking for info on Pumphouse Creek, within the city limits of quad Craig B-4. It crosses under the highway through a culvert. Jim Durst tells me "the catalog used to have it cataloged for P well above the road, but had it connected to the stream mouth that was filled in behind the Rocky Mountain Helicopter bunkhouse. We got the mouth moved, but they dropped the cataloging. I got it back cataloged for CO up to the road based on trapping and connectivity."

I don't see it on the latest Atlas or in the 1998/99 version of the catalog itself. Of course I don't know what the stream number is, for sure: I'm guessing that it may be (or have been) 103-60-10501, because -10500 is Crab Creek (a sizable stream), and 10502 and 10503 are the two creeks just west of Pumphouse Creek.

Can you tell me anything about this creek? DOT is planning a trail that would cross it upstream of the highway, which has a perched culvert. If it's not in the system, would the easiest thing be to re-nominate it? Thanks.
