

It was determined, based on the finding of juvenile coho salmon, that the cataloged portion of stream 103-40-10170 should be extended by 350 meters. The location of the stream was also confirmed and needs to be changed from the existing catalog location (see map).


Action: Add 350 meters to the cataloged portion of stream 103-40-10170 and adjust the location of the stream on the existing catalog.
