

The lines on the photo are a compilation of the AWC and the USFS arcs. I believe the mainstem was what the USFS showed and the tribs were added per the AWC. Neither the USFS arcs or AWC data appear to be in the correct location and I was trying to get some input on correcting that. Should I just eyeball it based on the original nomination or leave them as is until we get better info?

Jim,

I am familiar with this area of Luck Lake but not enough to know the exact location of the tributaries. Obviously the lines drawn on the photo are considerably different from the sketch included with the nomination. What was the source of the streams drawn on the photo? As the stream is drawn on the sketch with the whole of the nomination being located rather close to the lake, and none of it located above the road, I wonder why the lines on the photo go so far up the hill? The main road that runs along the lake is the FS 3030 road and I doubt that the stream would be anadromous above the road due to gradient. FS GIS shows the main tributary as a Class III above the 3030 road. Without going out and looking at the stream on the ground, I am afraid that I can not give any more help. I am however, going to be looking at some culverts in this area for FS T-16 concurrence and could take a look at the area if need be. Let me know.


Jim,

Luck Lake tributaries. 106-10-10300-2008, 2008-3008, and 2008-3012 as depicted on the attached JPEG don't appear to be right. For one the tribs don't match up with the mainstem. Also they don't appear to be lying in the right place over the photo. I'm also concerned that they may have been drawn longer than what they should have been based on the sketch in the original nomination. The original nom is attached in PDF form. Can you take a look at your files, staff first hand knowledge or other resources and see if you can tell where they are suppose to be? Then draw them in so we can make the edits. Thanks.

Also I noticed that the Petersburg office contact info isn't on the web site. Is there a reason for this? I thought it was there at one point. Maybe not. Do you want it there?
