**Comments:**  
On May 28, 2003, as part of a FRPA field inspection, an electrofisher was used to determine the presence of coho juveniles in a stream that is a "branch" of Bazaan Creek, stream number 104-20-10650. The stream to be added to the catalog is a Karst stream that originates from Bazaan Creek, flows underground, and resurges to the west of Bazaan Creek approximately 1300 feet from saltwater. The resurgence is located immediately to the east of Sealaska Timber Co. 3780 Road. The stream has a gravel/cobble substrate. No adults were observed due to the time of the year but suitable spawning habitat is present throughout most of the reach. A gradient barrier exists where the stream resurges.

Action: Add 1300 feet of stream to the AWC for coho from just east of the STC 3780 Road where the stream resurges down to saltwater.






