

On September 30, Roy Josephson and I inspected a tributary to Granite Creek to determine whether a riparian buffer is required to protect fish habitat in the proposed Glacier Side II Timber Sale in the Haines State Forest. The tributary (Stream No. 115-32-10250-2077-3451-4010) runs through Unit 5 of the proposed sale, but the cataloged portion of the stream ends below the unit. We hiked the creek from the cataloged reach to the upstream end of the unit and did not find any blockage to anadromous fish passage. Therefore, the riparian standards for state land (AS 41.17.118) apply to Unit 5.

The stream is typically 3-5 feet wide, less than 1 foot deep, with a gradient of about 1-3%, and is cataloged for coho salmon and Dolly Varden char. We placed a trap in a pool below a small cascade located at the eastern border of Unit 5 (59° 25.043'N; 136° 18.376' W) and caught 6 cutthroat trout about 3-1/2 to 6 inches total length. We were unable to trap farther upstream within the unit because our salmon egg bait had liquified. Since cutthroat trout have not been documented in the stream, I will nominate cutthroat trout to be added to the catalog.

We found a 36-inch culvert along the abandoned access road above the confluence with Granite Creek (59° 25.086' N; 136°18.122 W) that is undersized and needs to be upgraded. A Fish Habitat Permit will be required under AS 41.14.870 to replace this culvert, and for a new crossing farther upstream for the proposed access road.
