The fish sampling activities on the Juneau Ranger District for the 2008 field season were as follows:

Location: St. James Bay (58.63114N, 135.21913W)

Date: August 27th and 28th.

Species: Coho, Dolly Varden, Sculpin.

On August 27th and 28th 37 coho, 17 Dolly Varden, and 2 scuplin were captured on a small, unnamed stream with baited minnow traps in association with a stream restoration project. A failing log stringer bridge was removed to provide fish passage. Prior to removal, the upstream and downstream portions of the creek were blocked with fine mesh netting. The enclosed area was saturated with minnow traps and the traps soaked for about two hrs. The fish were removed from the work site and released upstream and downstream of the block nets. No mortalities occurred, and there were no measurements taken. This was a joint project with ADF&G habitat division. Brian Glynn was not contacted before this project.

This was the only activity that was associated with this permit.


