Montana Creek (Stream No. 111-50-10500-2003) Tributary

Habitat Biologist Jackie Timothy and I tracked and trapped this stream on 5-11-10. This is a small stream (about 2' wide), that appears to provide excellent rearing habitat. The stream runs along the Montana Creek road/ trail. Directly upstream on the culvert there is a small waterfall that is a fish barrier at the current water level. There are no other barriers found on the stream.
