Montana Creek (Stream No. 111-50-10500-2003) Tributary


Habitat Biologist Jackie Timothy and I tracked and trapped this stream on 5-11-10. This tributary connects to another uncataloged tributary flowing into Montana Creek. The last waypoint (23) is below a possible barrier. The stream provides excellent rearing habitat. Water level was very low during the survey. No barriers between wp 19 and 23.
