Tributary addition to creek # 115-10-10230

During the dates of Monday, September 20th through Wednesday, September 22nd, Sport Fish technician David Leonard and I surveyed creek # 115-10-10230 and found an uncataloged tributary below the road. We surveyed the trib with a Garmin GPS and trapped it with baited minnow traps and found it to contain rearing coho salmon. The following table provides sample data and the map illustrates trap sites and feature locations.




Coho captured at waypoint 13




Cutthroat captured at waypoint 11.
