

It also provides an additional nomination for presence of juvenile cutthroat trout. This information was collected as part of the ADF&G Fish Passage Project. Upstream trap was located 30' from the culvert and produced 4 juvenile coho and 1 juvenile/adult cutthroat trout. Downstream trap was located 10' from culvert and produced 8 juvenile coho, 1 and juvenile/adult cutthroat trout.


