



> Dear Mr. Tucker,  
>  
> Thank you for bringing this issue to our attention. We have verified  
> that the names were indeed reversed in GNIS. Although the original  
> 1960 case files (attached to the GNIS entries) were somewhat vague in  
> their descriptions and coordinates, we agree that Sitkum Creek should  
> be a tributary of Jenny Creek, and that Jenny Creek is the more northerly stream.  
>  
> Because GNIS is feature-oriented, we have reversed the names for each  
> GNIS entry, rather than retain the names and reverse the coordinates,  
> i.e. FID  
> 1422839 is now Sitkum Creek and FID 1414745 is now Jenny Creek. The  
> coordinates in each entry have also been corrected to agree with the  
> NHD flowlines.  
>  
> The corrections should appear at the public GNIS page in the next  
> 24-48 hours. Please review them and let us know if you see any  
> problems (other than the new elevation figures, which are clearly  
> wrong. We are investigating that issue).  
>  
> Thanks again for your interest and assistance. I'm also including the  
> Alaska NHD points of contact so they are aware that NHD needs correcting.  
>

Hi J,

It was just brought to my attention that the stream names listed with 109-42-10050-2002 and 109-42-10050 may be backwards. The AWC lists -10050-2002 as Jenny Creek, but the road signage and the USGS topo call this Stikum Creek. Similarly, the AWC lists -10050 as Stikum Creek, while the road signage and USGS topo call it Jenny Creek.
