Upon reviewing the Southeastern Region Catalog of Waters Important for Spawning, Rearing and Migration of Anadromous Fishes, it has become obvious that the available published information regarding salmon and trout species found in S.E. streams has not been incorporated. Data from the following publications should be included in this catalog.

- 1) Edgington, J. and J. Eastwood. 1981. Stream Habitat Inventory, Bradfield Canal and North Etolin Island. Alaska Department of Fish and Game. Vols. 1 & 2.
- 2) Edgington, J. and B. Lynch. 1982. Stream Habitat Inventory, Kadake Bay, Port Camden, Eastern Rocky Pass, Totem Bay, and Upper Duncan Canal. Alaska Department of Fish and Game. Vols. 1 & 2.

We shouldn't have to reinvent the wheel each time this stream inventory subject comes up.

Concerning the numbering of streams, we in Commercial Fish do not plan to adopt the Habitat numbering system. Generally, the two systems are compatible except on complex drainages such as the Stikine River. It seems it would not have been that hard to incorporate our numbering system on the Stikine somewhere in the Habitat number.
