About 25 adult spawning chum salmon were observed in a 100 meter stretch of this stream at the point shown on the enclosed map. No chum salmon were observed above a log jam that may hinder their passage. The log jam did not appear to be capable of blocking coho or steelhead. Surveys further up the drainage are needed to verify if coho and steelhead utilize upstream habitat.
