This small stream does not contain exceptional habitat but a few rearing coho were observed utilizing it. The substrate is fairly compact and may not be utilized for spawning. A survey during peak coho escapement is needed to determine spawning use. The mainstem boundary for coho use needs to be adjusted up to this tributary.
