Several coho fry were observed even though the water was very dark. Some fair quality spawning substrate is available, indicating probable spawning use. Very possible coho use above sample point as the stream gradient continued in the moderate range for a short distance stream had been clearcut to both banks and appeared to have been subjected to stream clearance work, potential lowering habitat quality for coho.
