Anadromous Waters Catalog

Just had a chance to look at the revisions made to the Atlas and Catalog for 1994. Several things caught my eye:

- Craig B-3 stream 103-60-10590 (Saint Nicholas River). I submitted a deletion last year, with the location of a barrier falls marked. The upper extent in the Atlas is still too far upstream. Please refer to the map I submitted, or call if you need additional information.
- Craig B-3 stream 103-60-10590-2006 (Wolf Creek). I submitted a deletion and correction last year, but no action appears to have been taken. If you need additional information, please contact me. NO RECORD OF IT.
- Craig B-4 streams 103-50-10490 and 103-50-1???? (unnamed tributaries to Port Refugio). I submitted changes to these streams last year, but no action appears to have been taken. I have resubmitted the requests in slightly different forms this year. If you need additional information, please contact me. NO RECORD OF IT.

One piece of old business. In 1992, I submitted numerous changes to the Craig A-3 stream 103-25-10500 (Saltery Creek) system. I do not have good copies of what was sent in, but part of the package should have included relocating tributaries -2002, -2004, and -2006 to their correct locations. In the process, -2004 was apparently dropped. Could you check on whether this was intentional or an accident? I could probably recreate the nomination for correction if that is necessary, but it would not be easy.

Thanks for your help with all this.
