**Comments:** Two baited minnow traps were placed, at 1455 on 9/20/96, in a tributary on the south side of 114-23-10070-2009. After a 45 minute soak 53 coho salmon fry were captured. The traps were placed about 50 yards upstream of the confluence with the cataloged stream. The traps were not placed at the limits of anadromous fish habitat, the quality of rearing habitat appears high.
