**Comments:** The following observations were made during a Forest Practices Inspection on August 14, 1997. This stream is cataloged for pink salmon only, no pink salmon were noted in the stream or intertidal area. This stream appears to contain very good rearing and reasonable spawning habitat for coho salmon. The substrate is gravel and sand with a 1% - 2% grade, abundant LWD created pools and riffles. There is a beaver dam approximately 300 meters from tide water, one coho was captured with the electroshocker above this dam. Logging spur road 4610 is proposed to cross this stream approximately 100 meters above the beaver dam, another coho was captured in this location. Fish habitat appears to continue beyond reach sampled, but time was not available to sample further. The limits of sampling are noted on the attached map.


