Comments: This nomination (12.03mp) is a tributary of the Yahtse River (10100). During our field trip in June we used a minnow trap to verify coho in this system. The trap was left soaking for 90 minutes and 26 juvenile coho were identified and released. This systems flows directly into the Yahtse 11.53 mp nomination submitted this year also. The gradient at this location is extremely flat and this particular system flows through several lakes. A GPS way point was taken at the 38' log stringer bridge that crosses this system in Section 5: N.59 51.700, W.141 09.573.


