Comments: On October 9, 2000, stream 103-40-10240, located at T.76S., R.82E., Sections 27 and 34, was inspected using an electrofisher in order to determine the upper extent of anadromous fish habitat. It was determined, based on the finding of juvenile coho salmon, that the cataloged portion of stream 103-40-10240 should be extended by 1409 meters. It was confirmed that the two lakes which feed stream 103-40-10240 both flow to the south (see map).


