Comments: During field inspections along Island Lake Creek on November 13 and 15, 2002 adult spawning coho salmon and carcasses were noted up to the driveway culvert at 1713 Selief Lane. Three adult coho were noted below this culvert, adult carcasses were noted between Island Lake and Mill Bay, live adults were noted in the outlet culvert at Mill Bay, and Steve Honnold noted that he had observed 15 - 20 adults in a pool below the falls the prior week.

The stream hydrography also needs to be corrected in the AWC per the attached 1:25,000 scale map. The lake point for Horseshoe Lake 259-10-10035-0040 needs to be moved also to more accurately depict it's location.
