55° 29.191.4' N lat.
160° 57.713.4 W long.

has an official USGS name?

The creek emptys into Beaver Bay on the south side of the AK Peninsula between McGinty Point Creek and Beaver River. We refer to the creek as Not Smiley's Creek but it is not listed in the Dictionary of AK Place Names (Orth) or named on a USGS topo map. It's statistical number in the Anadromous Stream Catalog is 283-70-10400 and it's found on Port Moller B-3 (mouth) and C-3 topo maps.

If this creek does not have an official name, do you know what the process is to get this creek officially designated Arnie's Creek?
