Comments:

During a joint Forest Practices inspection we located a perched 30-inch diameter wood stave culvert in an unnamed tributary to Sequel Point Creek. The culvert is a barrier to fish passage. The stream width is about 4 feet with a slope of less than 5%. I used an electrofisher to sample a pool below the culvert outlet capturing juvenile fish. Because of the current velocity I did not identify the fish species. I sampled about 400 linear feet of stream below the culvert. I captured and released one steelhead or rainbow trout and juvenile Dolly Varden.


