



IF IT WAS HIM HE WOULD DELETE IT, COULD JUST SHORTEN IT IF WANT. DEFINITELY TO LONG AND NOT UP SIDE OF MOUNTAIN. ADDITIONALLY, THEY FOUND THAT RAINBOWS STOCKED IN 306-50-11300 IN THE '50'S HAVE ESTABLISHED A POPULATION IN THE LOWER SECTION OF THAT RIVER, AND SOME HAVE MOVED INTO 11250.
