
**Comments:** In mid-July and mid-August I was fishing in a tributary of the snake River and caught several coho fingerlings. I also observed several others (approximately 4 dozen and 1 dozen respectively). These fingerlings were identified by my father, who has extensive experience using Fish and Game salmon identification manuals. The location where I caught these specifically, is where the snake lake road crosses the tributary. This observation extends the upper range of rearing coho in this tributary.
