Comments: From 6/17 to 9/20/98 THE U.S. FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE RESEARCHED DOLLY VARDEN IN THE TOGIAC RIVER DRAINAGE. WHILE SEINING, INCIDENTAL CATCHES OF ROUND WHITEFISH WERE DOCUMENTED. THIS DATA SUPPORTS THE ATLAS, WHICH SHOWS WHITEFISH UP INTO THE IZAVIEKNIK RIVER. WE DOCUMENTED WHITEFISH FROM 59° 15' 29" N, 160° 11' 40" W UP TO 59° 25' 03" N, 159° 48' 03" W. A TOTAL OF 430 WHITE FISH WERE RECORDED FROM THESE TWO LOCATIONS AND MANY POINTS OF SEINING IN BETWEEN.
