Comments: I ASSESS SALMON ESCAPMENTS FOR ADF+G, BY AERIAL SURVEY FROM SMALL PLANES (AT ~ 500 TO 1000'). SEVERAL TIMES IN PAST YEARS I OBSERVED SALMON SPAWNING IN THE UPPER REACHS OF WATCHOUT CREEK, ABOVE THE DISTRIBUTION DOCUMENTED IN THE AWC. IN 1998 I SAW APPROX. 1200 PINK SALMON SPAWNING IN THE AREA MARKED ON ATTACHED MAP ON 8/1. ON 9/8 I SAW APPROX 400 PINK SALMON CARCASSES IN THE SAME AREA. I HAVE ALSO MARKED WHAT I BELIEVE TO BE THE UPPER LIMIT TO SALMON PASSAGE. ABOVE THIS POINT THE STREAM BECOMES A SERIES OF CATARACTS AND STEEP FALLS.
