

Montana Creek (Stream No. 111-50-10500-2003) Tributary

Habitat Biologist Jackie Timothy and I tracked and trapped this stream on 5-11-10. This tributary connects to another uncataloged tributary flowing into Montana Creek. The last waypoint (18) is below a possible barrier. The stream provides excellent rearing habitat. Water level was very low during the survey.

17	58.4365, -134.6454	Trap, 2 cutthroat Trout 50mm, 2 coho 50mm
18	58.4364, -134.6460	Waterfall, possible barrier
