


Bessie Creek Route Correction

I surveyed this stream with Habitat biologists Joe Hitzelberger and Johnny Zutz on July 14th, 2010. We found the actual stream route to be inconsistent with the cataloged route. The following table and map provide survey data and feature locations. The coordinates given for the upper and lower extents are for the existing cataloged species.


