**Findings:** This stream’s route and location differs from that illustrated in the Anadromous Waters Catalog, and should be updated to reflect the true route, which was tracked on the ground with a GPS. Waypoint 99 is the upper extent, and waypoint 96 is the lower extent.

**Recommendations:** Update the stream’s route to reflect sinuosity and accurate upper and lower extents. Remove COpr from the list as that species, lifestage, and location is unsubstantiated.




Figure 2.-Looking upstream from the base of the bottom bedrock cascade..
