EXPLANATION:

This emergency order opens the area from the Homer City Dock near the entrance to the Homer Boat Harbor northwest along the east side of the Homer Spit to the department marker placed approximately 200 yards northwest of the entrance to the fishery enhancement lagoon on the Homer Spit, to a distance of 300 feet from the shore, to snagging. Snagging will be permitted only from noon, Friday, June 28 until 11:59 p.m., Sunday, July 7.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 58.030 (c), (d) and (e) are superceded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective:

5 AAC 58.030 (c), (d) and (e). METHODS, MEANS AND GENERAL PROVISIONS – FINFISH.

No person may snag or attempt to snag any species of fish east of a line from Anchor Point to Point Pogibshi from January 1 through June 23. Fish hooked elsewhere than in the mouth must be released immediately. "Snag" means hook a fish elsewhere than in the mouth. From the Homer City Dock near the entrance to the Homer Boat Harbor northwest along the east side of the Homer Spit to the department marker placed approximately 200 yards northwest of the entrance to the fishery enhancement lagoon on the Homer Spit, to a distance of 300 feet from the shore, snagging is permitted only from noon, Friday, June 28 to 11:59 p.m., Sunday, July 7.

JUSTIFICATION:

In 1988, the Alaska Board of Fisheries adopted a regulation whereby snagging would be permitted on and adjacent to the Homer Spit only after June 23 and only by emergency order. The department would issue an emergency order only if there were stocked salmon in the enhancement lagoon that could not

be adequately harvested without snagging. These criteria have been met in that there are king salmon available that will not be adequately harvested unless angler efficiency is increased. This emergency order therefore permits snagging on and adjacent to the Homer Spit beginning at noon, Friday, June 28 and continuing through 11:59 p.m., Sunday, July 7.
