EXPLANATION:

This emergency order opens Ketchikan Creek to sport fishing from August 24 through September 14, 2004. It allows a bag and possession limit of two king salmon 28 inches or greater in length and two king salmon less than 28 inches in length. The bag and possession limit for all other salmon 16 inches or more is two per day in the aggregate, and two in possession. Only unbaited, single hook, artificial lures may be used.

REGULATION:

The provisions of **5 ACC 47. 023. (i)(6) (B) and (C)** are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective:

5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

- (i) in the Ketchikan vicinity:
- (6) in Ketchikan Creek, excluding City Park Ponds,
 - (B) sport fishing is allowed from August 24 – September 14, 2004.
 - (C) the bag and possession limit for king salmon,
 - (i) 28 inches or greater in length is two fish;
 - (ii) less than 28 inches in length is two fish.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Alaska Board of Fisheries granted the department emergency order authority to increase sport fish bag and possession limits when hatchery produced fish escape through existing fisheries to designated harvest areas in numbers that exceed brood stock needs or any natural spawning requirements. Salmon present in Ketchikan Creek are in excess to brood stock and escapement requirements.

The daily bag and possession limit for king salmon in Ketchikan Creek from August 24 through September 14 is two king salmon 28 inches or more in length and two king salmon less than 28 inches in length. The daily bag and possession limit for all other salmon 16 inches or more is two per day in the aggregate, and two in possession

Ketchikan Creek will remain open from September 15, 2004 through May 15, 2005, by regulation, for all species except king salmon. The bag limit for all other salmon (in combination) will remain at two fish per day and in possession, 16 inches or more in length.
