EXPLANATION:

This emergency order establishes a bag and possession limit of four king salmon for the fresh waters of Glacier, Moraine, and Crystal lakes located within the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area in Juneau.

REGULATION:

The following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Thursday May 24, 2012 through Monday, December 31, 2012:

5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

(e) In the Juneau vicinity:

(1) in all drainages crossed by the Juneau City and Borough road system,

(M) in Glacier Lake, Moraine Lake, and Crystal Lake, the bag and possession limit is four king salmon.

JUSTIFICATION

The Alaska Board of Fisheries authorized the department to use its emergency order authority to increase sport bag and possession limits for hatchery-produced fish when there are no other competing user groups (5 AAC 75.003). One thousand five hundred catchable hatchery produced king salmon were stocked into Glacier, Moraine, and Crystal lakes on May 18, 2012, to provide additional sport fishing opportunity. Therefore, the department is establishing a bag and possession limit of four king salmon for these waters.
