EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases bag and possession limits for sockeye salmon on the Situk River to 6 per day and 12 in possession.


REGULATION: The provisions of 5 AAC 5 AAC 47.023 (b) (8) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order the following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, July 3 through Tuesday, December 31, 2013:

5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska area.

(b) (8) in the Lost River and Ahrnklin River and all drainages flowing into or between the Lost River and Ahrnklin River, the bag and possession limits for sockeye salmon is a bag limit of three fish and a possession limit of six fish, except that in the Situk River the bag limit is 6 sockeye salmon per day and the possession limit is 12 sockeye salmon.

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal range for sockeye salmon on the Situk River is 30,000 to 70,000 fish. As of June 30, 2013, more than 54,000 sockeye salmon have been counted through the Situk River weir, and counts are continuing to increase. Average run timing data for sockeye salmon on the Situk River indicates that greater than 50% of the run is still to come, and the escapement goal range will be exceeded. Increasing the sockeye salmon bag and possession limits will increase harvest opportunity for anglers, and will not put achievement of the escapement goal in jeopardy.
