EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit in the Saltery Cove drainage for sockeye salmon. Beginning 12:01 a.m., Thursday, July 4, the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon in the Saltery Cove drainage is 10 fish per day, 10 in possession.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 64.022 Waters; seasons; bag, possession, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area. (b) (5) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order the following provisions are effective beginning 12:01 a.m., Thursday, July 4, 2013.

5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area.

(b)(5) In the Saltery Cove drainage, the bag and possession limit for salmon, other than king salmon, is 10 per day, 10 in possession, of which, no more than five may be pink and chum salmon, and two may be coho salmon.

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal for sockeye salmon into the Saltery Cove drainage is 15,000 to 35,000 fish. As of June 30, approximately 20% of the way into the run, the weir count was greater than 10,000 sockeye. Based on historic run timing, the department is projecting the escapement goal will be exceeded. To provide additional sport fish harvest opportunity for sockeye salmon surplus to the escapement goal, as authorized in 5 AAC 75.003 (2) (A), the limit in the Saltery Cove drainage is increased to 10 per day, 10 in possession.
