REGULATION:

Consistent with the COPPER RIVER PERSONAL USE DIP NET SALMON FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN, 5 AAC 77.591, the personal use dip net salmon fishery in the Chitina Subdistrict of the Upper Copper River District will be open from 12:01 a.m. Monday June 10 through 11:59 p.m. Sunday June 16.

JUSTIFICATION:

During May 27 – June 2, there were 72,521 salmon counted past the Miles Lake sonar. The preseason projection for this period was 126,282 salmon, which results in a deficit of 53,761 salmon. Copper River sockeye salmon migratory timing and the previous five-year average harvest and participation rates indicate sufficient numbers of salmon available to maintain 168 hours of fishing time during the week of June 10-June 16.
