EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the Situk River drainage sport fishery to the retention of king salmon 20 inches or greater in length. Any king salmon 20 inches or greater in length may not be removed from the water and must be released immediately.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 47.023 (b) (6) (A) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Friday, May 8 through December 31, 2015:

5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska area.

(b) (6) In the Situk River drainage,

(A) King salmon greater than 20 inches in length may not be retained. Any king salmon 20 inches or greater in length may not be removed from the water and must be released immediately.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Situk River drainage is managed for a biological escapement goal of 450 to 1,050 large king salmon. In 2010-2012 the Situk River king salmon goal was not achieved. In 2013 and 2014 the goal was achieved after restrictions were implemented in the sport and commercial fisheries. The 2015 pre-season forecast is for a total run of approximately 600 large king salmon. Given recent fishery and harvest trends, a run of that size is not expected to achieve the escapement goal without pre-season fishery restrictions.
