Sport Fishing Regulations 2007-2008



---

➔ **BAIT PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES** ~ Only unbaited, artificial lures may be used.

---

**SEASONS** Open year-round for all species found in this system.

---

## HARVEST AND SIZE LIMITS

**Cutthroat and rainbow trout (in combination):** 1 daily, 1 in possession,  
25-inch minimum size limit

**Dolly Varden:** 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions

**Kokanee (landlocked salmon):** 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions.

## METHODS AND MEANS

Fish may NOT be taken in fresh water by means of: (1) fixed or weighted hooks and lures (except those of standard manufacture), (2) multiple hooks with a gap between point and shank larger than one-half inch, (3) spear, or (4) arrow.

It is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish in fresh water. "Snag" means to hook a fish elsewhere than in its mouth. A fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in its mouth must be released immediately.
