



# Big Goat Lake

Sport Fishing Regulations 2007-2008

---

**BAIT ALLOWED YEAR-ROUND** (No live bait allowed in fresh water)

---

## SEASONS, HARVEST, AND SIZE LIMITS

**Big Goat Lake contains only Arctic grayling.**

**Season:** Open year-round

**Limits:** 10 daily, 10 in possession, no size limit

---

## METHODS AND MEANS

Fish may NOT be taken in fresh water by means of: (1) fixed or weighted hooks and lures (except those of standard manufacture), (2) multiple hooks with a gap between point and shank larger than one-half inch, (3) spear, or (4) arrow.

It is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish in fresh water. "Snag" means to hook a fish elsewhere than in its mouth. A fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in its mouth must be released immediately.
