



Hasselborg Lake & Creek

Sport Fishing Regulations 2007-2008



Hasselborg Lake ➔ **BAIT PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES** ~ Only unbaited, artificial lures may be used.

Hasselborg Creek ➔ **NO BAIT:** Nov. 16—Sept. 14
➔ **LIVE BAIT PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**

SEASON Open year-round for all species found in this system.

HARVEST AND SIZE LIMITS

Cutthroat and rainbow trout (in combination):

Hasselborg Lake ~ 1 daily, 1 in possession, 25-inch minimum size limit

Hasselborg Creek ~ 2 daily, 2 in possession, 11-inch minimum and 22-inch maximum size limit (harvested cutthroat and rainbow trout must be at least 11 inches long but no greater than 22 inches long).

Dolly Varden: 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions.

Kokanee (landlocked salmon): 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions.

METHODS AND MEANS

Fish may NOT be taken in fresh water by means of: (1) fixed or weighted hooks and lures (except those of standard manufacture), (2) multiple hooks with a gap between point and shank larger than one-half inch, (3) spear, or (4) arrow.

It is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish in fresh water. “Snag” means to hook a fish elsewhere than in its mouth. A fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in its mouth must be released immediately.
