



# Lake Kathleen

## Sport Fishing Regulations 2007-2008



➔ **NO BAIT:** Nov. 16—Sept. 14  
Only unbaited artificial lures allowed.

➔ **LIVE BAIT PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**

**SEASONS** Open year-round for all species found in Lake Kathleen

### HARVEST AND SIZE LIMITS

**Cutthroat and rainbow trout (in combination):**

2 daily, 2 in possession, 11-inch minimum and 22-inch maximum size limit  
(harvested cutthroat and rainbow trout must be at least 11 inches long but no greater than 22 inches long).

**Dolly Varden:** 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions

**Kokanee (landlocked salmon):** 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions.

### METHODS AND MEANS

Fish may NOT be taken in fresh water by means of: (1) fixed or weighted hooks and lures (except those of standard manufacture), (2) multiple hooks with a gap between point and shank larger than one-half inch, (3) spear, or (4) arrow.

It is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish in fresh water. "Snag" means to hook a fish elsewhere than in its mouth. A fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in its mouth must be released immediately.
