Sport Fishing Regulations 2007-2008



➔ **BAIT PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES** ~ Only unbaited, artificial lures may be used.

SEASONS Open year-round for all species found in this freshwater system
EXCEPT KING SALMON ~ **King salmon season is closed year-round.**

HARVEST AND SIZE LIMITS

Cutthroat trout:

1 daily, 1 in possession, 25-inch minimum size limit.

Dolly Varden: 10 daily, 10 in possession; no size restrictions.

Coho, pink, chum and sockeye (including kokanee) salmon—in combination:

16 inches or longer:	2 daily, 2 in possession.
Less than 16 inches:	10 daily, 10 in possession.

METHODS AND MEANS

Fish may NOT be taken in fresh water by means of: (1) fixed or weighted hooks and lures (except those of standard manufacture), (2) multiple hooks with a gap between point and shank larger than one-half inch, (3) spear, or (4) arrow.

It is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish in fresh water. “Snag” means to hook a fish elsewhere than in its mouth. A fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in its mouth must be released immediately.
