

# General Management Plan for the Stocked Fisheries within Region III

## INTRODUCTION

Region III of the Sport Fish Division is the largest region and offers the most diverse recreational angling opportunities within the state of Alaska. Recently, angling opportunities in and around urban centers have shifted. Increasing fishing effort and harvest that once focused solely on wild stocks is now considerably diverted towards the Sport Fish Division's stocked fisheries program. The program has allowed fishing effort and harvest to grow while protecting wild stocks. Anglers and businesses value the stocked fisheries program because it provides angling opportunities that normally would not be present and it benefits local economies through the sales of fishing related sporting goods and guiding services.

In concert with the increase in demand for stocked fish there has been a pronounced shift in anglers demanding that more diverse angling opportunities be offered within the stocked fisheries program. With such changes in angler behavior, and additional hatchery production fluctuations, a stocked fisheries management plan was developed in 2004.

The purpose of this plan is to provide the department and Board of Fisheries the capability to manage the stocked fisheries program in accordance with the kind of sport angling opportunity desired by the public. The plan consists of three categories of stocked fisheries: Regional Management, Conservative Management, and Special Management<sup>1</sup>. In addition, water bodies are further stratified into 4 Sub-Categories (Large, Urban, Rural, and Remote) based on angler participation, ease of access, and proximity to major population centers. This classification system, combined with public input and hatchery production, determines the stocking schedule used by the department. To accommodate public demand for new and changing fisheries, provisions have been outlined for adding *New Water Bodies* and *Moving Water Bodies to a Different Category*.

There are 125 lakes in the stocked fisheries program that are located in Region III. Most lakes are along, or easily accessed from, the highway system. Presently, there are 51 stocked lakes within the Lower Tanana River Management Area (Fairbanks), 47 stocked lakes within the Upper Tanana River Management Area (Delta Junction), and 27 stocked lakes within the Upper Copper/Upper Susitna Management Area (Glennallen). Overall, in the regional management category there are 118 lakes, in the conservative management category there are 2 lakes, and in the special management category there are 5 lakes. Within the Regional Management category there are 4 large lakes (Birch, Chena, Quartz, and Silver) and 19 urban, 81 rural and 14 remote lakes.

## MANAGEMENT CATEGORIES

### REGIONAL MANAGEMENT LAKES

**Description:** The majority of stocked fisheries in Region III (94%) are in this category because most anglers generally want to harvest a large portion of their catch. These fisheries are open all year and have liberal bag limits and minimal restrictions. While most of the stocked fisheries are

along or near the road system where the potential fishing effort is greatest, others are more remote and are typically less crowded due to additional effort required for access. The more remote stocked fisheries usually have fish population structures with a greater proportion of large fish.

**Fishery Management Objective:** To create and maintain a fishery that provides for a reasonable expectation of catching the daily bag limit within a day's angling.

**Bag Limit:** 10 fish (all species combined).

**Length Limit:** Only 1 fish, (any species) greater than 18".

**Gear Restrictions:** None.

**Season:** Open all year unless specified.

#### **CONSERVATIVE MANAGEMENT LAKES**

**Description:** The stocked fisheries in this category are managed to provide a high catch rate but a low harvest to catch ratio. Stocking schemes and regulations are designed to create population structures where, compared to the Regional Management category, fish larger than 14 inches make up a greater proportion of the population. Fingerlings are usually stocked to keep fish transport costs reasonable. Only Dune Lake and Koole Lake are currently listed in this category.

**Fishery Management Objective:** To create and maintain the opportunity to catch and harvest the daily bag limit while providing the opportunity to catch 1 fish greater than 18" within a days angling.

**Bag Limit:** 5 fish (all species combined).

**Length Limit:** Only 1 fish (any species) 18 inches or greater.

**Season:** Open year round or potentially seasonally restricted.

**Gear:** None or moderate restrictions.

#### **SPECIAL MANAGEMENT LAKES**

**Description:** The stocked fisheries in this category have fishery characteristics deemed by the public as deserving special management. These lakes are productive and are typically managed to produce trophy size rainbow trout. Five lakes are in this category. Stocking schemes and regulations are designed to create population structures where, compared to the Conservative Management category, fish larger than 18 inches make up a greater proportion of the population.

**Fishery Management Objective:** Manage the fishery to maintain a high probability of catching several large fish within a days angling for an experienced angler.

**Bag Limit:** 1 fish, any species, or another appropriate bag and size limit or potentially catch and release.

**Season:** Seasonal restrictions possible.

**Gear:** Open to public input, no bait, and single-hook artificial or artificial fly only.

## SUB-CATEGORIES

**Large-** Lakes greater than 250 surface acres with high angler participation relative to other systems within the area. Access is via well-established road systems and in some cases multiple access points. Stocking is performed on an annual basis for most species but alternate year stocking is also conducted.

**Urban-** Characterized by being within short driving distance from a population center and accessed via the road system. These systems receive multiple stockings throughout the year with catchable size fish to accommodate higher levels of angling pressure.

**Rural-** Located outside of major population centers with either road or short (<2 miles) access. These systems receive a single stocking of fish per year and are exposed to moderate or low angler pressure.

**Remote-** Defined by access being afforded either by a long trail or via aircraft. These lakes are generally stocked once per year, or in some cases alternate years, with fingerlings.

## NEW WATER BODIES AND MOVING WATER BODIES TO A DIFFERENT CATEGORY

Requests to nominate a new water body for stocking or to move an existing water body to a different category can originate with the public, local fish and game advisory committees, the Board of Fish, or the department. Any candidate water body must first meet *Statewide Stocking Policy* standards (A1-A11).

### NEW WATER BODY

When a water body is nominated for stocking it will by default be placed under the Regional Management category. The water body's size, physical and chemical properties, productivity, presence of other species, and access will be evaluated. The water body will be stocked when these factors indicate that a successful fishery can be established.

### MOVING TO DIFFERENT CATEGORY

The process of moving a water body to a different management category is driven by the public's desire to change the management goals for a water body. Generally, the characteristics of the water body (size, physical and chemical properties, productivity, presence of other species, and access) combined with the public's expectation of the fishery will determine the management category. The department and the public must consider what characteristics and resources are required for a successful fishery under the desired management category. Some questions to consider are:

1. What is the public's and the department's recommendation for management category;
2. Can the water body meet the criteria for the proposed management category;
3. What is the impact to other fisheries if the hatchery must modify fish production or fish must be moved from other fisheries;

4. What is the need for access improvements such as road, boat launch, and parking facilities; and,
5. What evaluation is required to monitor the fishery?

## **General Fish Stocking Plan for the Stocked Fisheries within Region III**

In 2004 the Board of Fish adopted the general management plan along with new regulations for the stocked fisheries in Region III<sup>2</sup>. The general management plan describes the main goals for the management of stocked fisheries and provides the background for the future development of more detailed, comprehensive management plans that will be specific to each major fishery and groups of smaller fisheries. It is the responsibility of the stocking program in Region III to meet these goals and fishery specific objectives.

Within the context of the new general management plan, the Region III General Fish Stocking Plan is updated annually. The General Fish Stocking Plan is a comprehensive list of the species, the life stage, the stocking frequencies, and the maximal numbers of fish that can be stocked for all lakes in the stocking program (Tables IIIa-c). The projected numbers of fish to be stocked annually for a five year period are listed in Tables III-AC, -KS, -SS, -GR, and -RT. The maximal numbers required for Fish Transport Permits (FTPs) now reference the maximal numbers in the Region III General Fish Stocking Plan Tables instead of the projected numbers. This change makes the stocking program more efficient and effective in meeting its goals and objectives given the current unstable conditions at the state fish hatcheries.

The hatcheries operated by Sport Fish Division in Anchorage are not meeting requests for the numbers and sizes of fish or release times. This situation likely will not improve until 2011 when the new Ruth Burnett Sport Fish Hatchery in Fairbanks begins producing fish for the Fairbanks, Delta, and Glennallen areas. Until then, the stocking program is faced with uncertain hatchery production and fishery managers must adapt stocking schemes to maintain acceptable fisheries. In addition, fishery managers must deal with unexpected sudden declines in fish abundance at popular fisheries and stocking restrictions to limit the possible spread of disease. Such conditions require a stocking program that can easily and quickly adapt to changes to prevent or mitigate the loss of recreational opportunities. Often, changes must be made with short notice as new hatchery and fishery information becomes available. The Region III General Fish Stocking Plan allows for faster response time, promotes a more flexible and efficient stocked fisheries program, and satisfies the requirements of both the Lake Stocking Policy for Sport Fish Division and the FTP application process.

The Statewide Stocking Plan for Recreational Fisheries (SSP) was primarily designed to meet fish hatchery needs; for that reason it does not easily handle the transfers of wild fish, the unplanned but necessary reallocation of hatchery fish between lakes, or contingency stocking plans that are designed to deal with production numbers that significantly fall short of or exceed projected numbers. These actions are increasingly important management tools for the fish stocked fisheries program, but they are left out of the SSP. The Region III General Fish Stocking Plan inserted in to the SSP combines all fish stocking activities in a single document, making it easier for the public to remain informed of the department's actions.
