



RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):
Pink, chum, coho. Timing late (Sept. - Oct.).
Spawning area 1459 m² (1/2 mile x 17' x 35% ASA)
Excellent rearing for coho

Schooling Areas: Scattered small pools throughout accessible portion.

Spawning Areas: Scattered riffles of varying quality.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Very limited, some clams

SPORT FISHERIES: Nominal

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Short distance from Ketchikan road system - access by boat and trail. Several cabins near stream mouth. Entire watershed within Tongass National Forest.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: None needed.

SOILS: Stable

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Bear, wolf tracks, scats, scattered salmon bones on banks. Deer tracks.
