RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):

Pink, chum, coho. High esc. 9-16-50 2000 pink, 50 chum. Low esc. 9-15-53 - none.
Timing late (Sept-Oct). Spawning area: 8241 m² (1000'x65'x60% ASA ITZ) + (2640'x30'x
20% ASA R.fork) + (1000'x40'x50% ASA L.fork to forks)+(1320'x30'x35% ASA R.fork of L.
fork). Good rearing.
Schooling Areas: Pools in intertidal zone and near high tide.

Spawning Areas: Intertidal area, limited areas above IT area dependent on above
normal water levels.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Unknown

SPORT FISHERIES: Trout, coho


LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Unknown, contained withing Tongass
National Forest.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: Large log jam on left fork and several small ones
on right fork could be removed to improve access by adults.

SOILS: Appeared stable throughout surveyed area.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Bear, deer, otter tracks and scats
noted.

Distance - 3/4 mile from ITZ.
